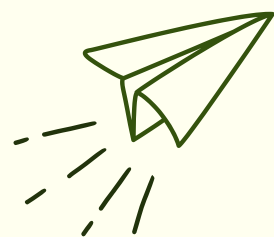

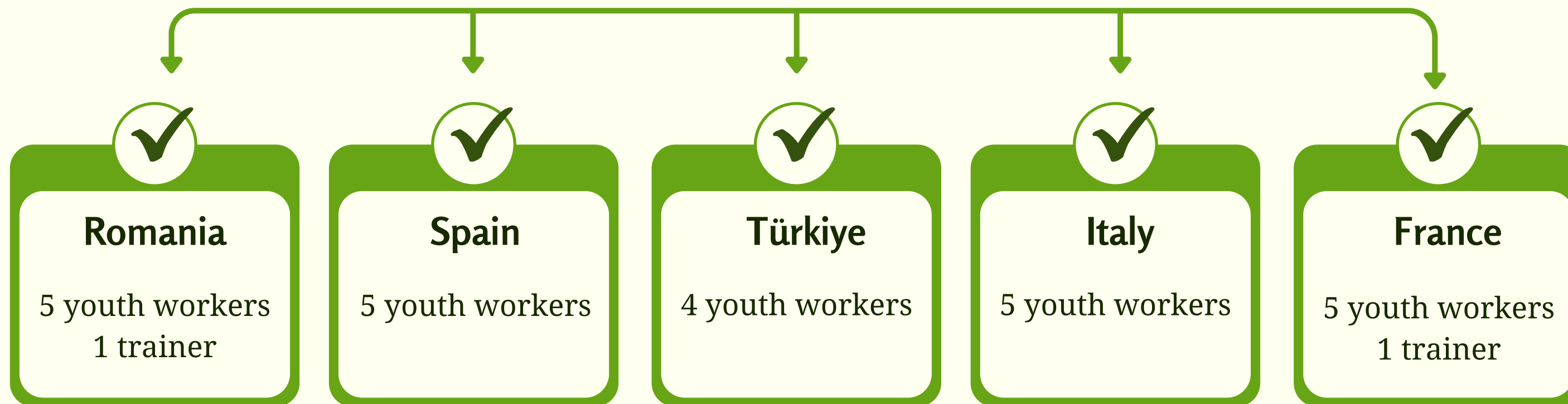
OBJECTIVES

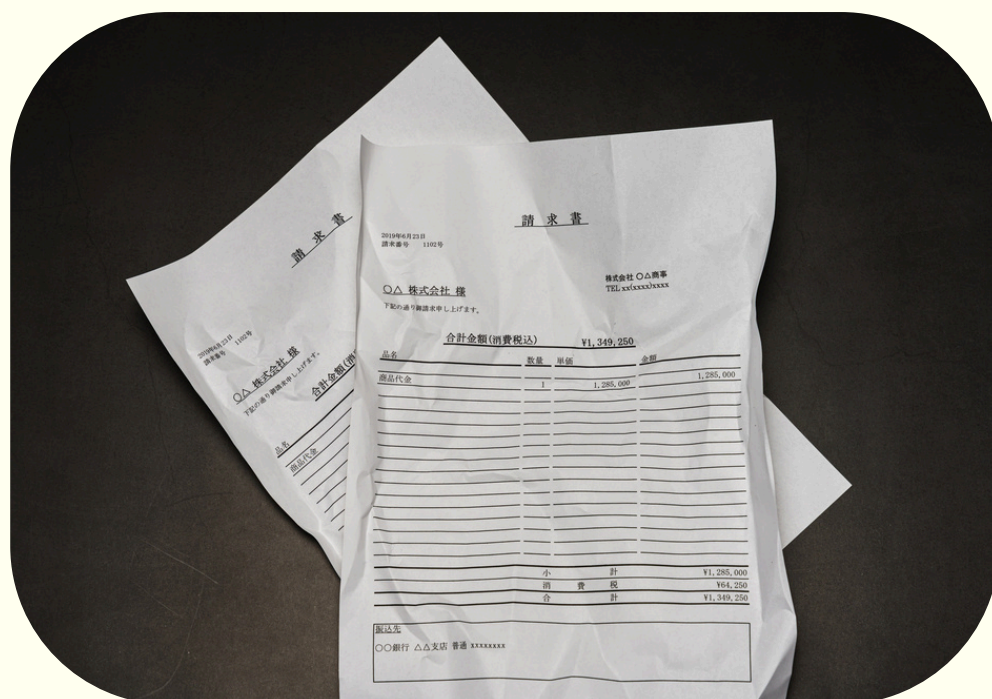

WHAT CAN BE ACCEPTED AS TRAVEL COSTS?



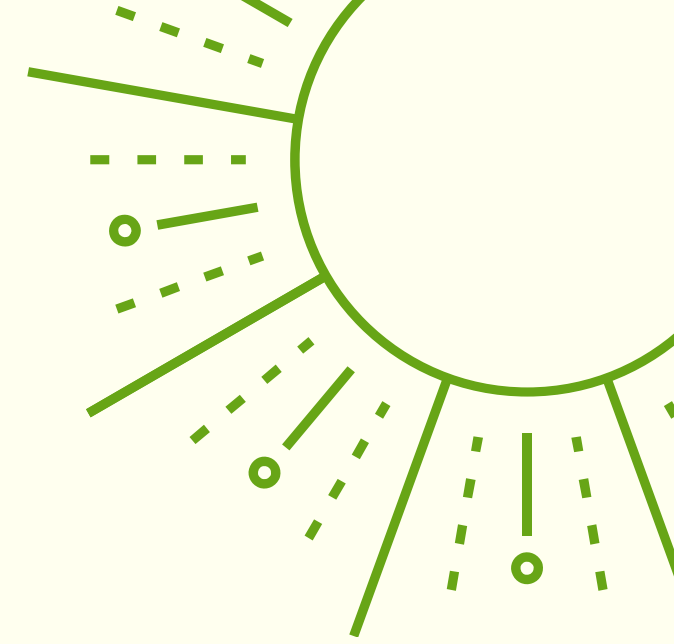
- Flight tickets; Public transport tickets (bus, ferry, train, metro etc.);

- Travel insurance.



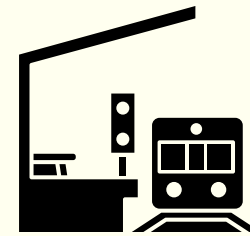
